ORDINANCE 2017 – 61

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH TIMBELO, INC. FOR INFRASTRUCTURE FOR THE CITYWIDE SIGNAL AND FIBER CONNECTION PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$35,000

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has a need to upgrade the City's signal system, install a fiber optic interconnect throughout much of the City's traffic management system, replace all traffic signal controllers with modern controllers that offer more advanced options for timing of signals, replace all school flasher controllers, purchase a school flasher control program, install two additional battery backup systems, install additional pan-tilt-zoom cameras for monitoring traffic, retrofit all pedestrian pushbuttons and pedestrian signal heads to meet new standards as well as replace deteriorated traffic signal heads and re-lamp the others; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has received a quote from Timbelo, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$35,000; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 133.05 of the Mason Codified Ordinances, competitive bidding is not required for such services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Timbelo, Inc., a Mason based company, in an amount not to exceed \$35,000.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Timbelo, Inc. the amount as set forth in the contract for said work.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
