ORDINANCE 2017 - 93

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH EVAPCO INC., IN THE AMOUNT OF \$72,013, TO FURNISH AND DELIVER A REPLACEMENT COOLING TOWER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Evapco, Inc., has submitted a quote for furnishing and delivering a new cooling tower to the Mason Municipal Center.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 133.05 of the Mason Codified Ordinances, competitive bidding is not required for such purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Evapco, Inc., in the amount of \$72,013 to furnish and deliver a new cooling tower to the Mason Municipal Center.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Evapco, Inc., an amount not to exceed \$72,013 pursuant to the terms of the contract.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this Ordinance shall be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare, and shall be effective immediately. The reason for the emergency is to enable the production of the cooling tower contemplated hereby to proceed as soon as possible.
