

ORDINANCE 2017 - 109

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MORTON SALT, INC. AS A SECONDARY SOURCE FOR THE PURCHASE OF HIGHWAY ROCK SALT AT \$53.50 PER TON

WHEREAS, Warren County has advertised and received bids for the purchase of bulk highway rock salt for snow and ice control; and

WHEREAS, The Detroit Salt Company, LLC was the lowest and best bidder in that process; and

WHEREAS, City Council has previously authorized the City Manager to enter into a contract with Detroit Salt Company, LLC for the purchase of highway rock salt pursuant to a separate and distinct public bidding process; and

WHEREAS, Morton Salt, Inc. was the second lowest bidder in the Warren County public bidding process with a bid of \$53.50 per ton; and

WHEREAS, City Council now desires to authorize the City Manager to enter into a separate contract for a secondary source of highway rock salt.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason accepts the Warren County bulk ice control salt specifications.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Morton Salt, Inc. as a secondary source for the purchase of highway rock salt.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said Morton Salt, Inc. the sum of \$53.50 per ton.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
