

ORDINANCE 2017 - 111

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SMITHCORP CONSTRUCTION SERVICES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$21,700, FOR LABOR AND MATERIAL RELATED TO THE FIRELINE INSTALLATION FOR FIRE DEPARTMENT TRAINING AT THE SERVICE CENTER ANNEX

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has received a quote, in the amount of \$21,700, from SmithCorp Construction Services to provide labor and materials related to the installation of a six-inch fireline for fire department training purposes at the Service Center Annex on U.S. 42; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 133.05 of the Mason Codified Ordinances, competitive bidding is not required for such purchase; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with SmithCorp Construction Services to provide labor and materials related to the installation of a six-inch fireline for fire department training purposes at the Service Center Annex on US 42.

Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay SmithCorp Construction Services to provide labor and materials related to the installation of a six-inch fireline for fire department training purposes at the Service Center Annex on US 42.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its adoption. The reason for said declaration of an emergency is the need to authorize the payment for the labor and materials at the earliest possible date.
