## **ORDINANCE 2017 - 123**

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FEDERAL SIGNAL IN THE AMOUNT OF \$22,360, FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF A NEW OUTDOOR WARNING SIREN

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has received a quote, in the amount of \$22,360, from Federal Signal for the purchase and installation of a new rotating electromechanical outdoor warning siren; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 133.05 of the Mason Codified Ordinances, competitive bidding is not required for such purchase; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Federal Signal for the purchase and installation of a new outdoor warning siren, substantially in the form of the contract attached hereto as Exhibit A, incorporated herein by reference.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Federal Signal an amount not to exceed \$22,360 pursuant to the terms of the contract for the purchase and installation of a new outdoor warning siren.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this Ordinance shall be effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
