

ORDINANCE 2017 - 123

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FEDERAL SIGNAL IN THE AMOUNT OF \$22,360, FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF A NEW OUTDOOR WARNING SIREN

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has received a quote, in the amount of \$22,360, from Federal Signal for the purchase and installation of a new rotating electromechanical outdoor warning siren; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 133.05 of the Mason Codified Ordinances, competitive bidding is not required for such purchase; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Federal Signal for the purchase and installation of a new outdoor warning siren, substantially in the form of the contract attached hereto as Exhibit A, incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Federal Signal an amount not to exceed \$22,360 pursuant to the terms of the contract for the purchase and installation of a new outdoor warning siren.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
