

ORDINANCE 2017 - 125

DECLARING CERTAIN CITY EQUIPMENT AND PROPERTY AS SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO DISPOSE OF SAID EQUIPMENT AND PROPERTY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council has determined that there is certain City equipment and miscellaneous property which are not needed or are unfit for public use as set out in Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City equipment and miscellaneous property set out in the attached Exhibit "A", and included herein by reference, are declared to be surplus property no longer needed for municipal purposes or unfit for public use.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to dispose of said property and equipment in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15, which authorizes the City Manager to sell said property, the estimated value of which is less than \$1,000, without any formal bidding procedure or to sell said personal property or equipment that exceeds \$1,000 after advertisement for not less than two nor more than four weeks to the highest and best bidder.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its adoption. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to declare the property as surplus at the earliest possible date in order to comply with proposed sale date.
