

ORDINANCE 2017 - 132

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL FOR THE MUDDY CREEK STABILIZATION PROJECT DESIGN FROM SUSTAINABLE STREAMS, LLC, IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FEE OF \$47,000 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, certain reaches of the Muddy Creek (between Mason-Montgomery Road and Kings Mills Road) and within the City of Mason are subject to severe erosion and are in need of restoration in order to preserve the natural quality of the stream and protect the adjacent bike path; and

WHEREAS, the City has requested design proposals from a number of qualified firms; and

WHEREAS, the proposal submitted by Sustainable Streams, Inc., has been determined to be the most responsive to the project requirements and at a competitive price.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the contract for the Muddy Creek Stabilization Project Design is awarded to Sustainable Streams, LLC, at the not to exceed proposed fee amount of \$47,000.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute contract documents with Sustainable Streams, LLC on behalf of the City of Mason.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is authorized to make payment to Sustainable Streams, LLC on the basis of approved payment applications, up to the contract amount of \$47,000.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
