

ORDINANCE 2017 - 135

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO MODIFY AN EXISTING CONTRACT WITH ANDRITZ SEPARATION, INC. FOR REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT OF EQUIPMENT AT THE WATER RECLAMATION PLANT IN AN ADDITIONAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$36,000 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has discovered certain repairs are necessary in the scroll and bowl components of a centrifuge at the Water Reclamation Plant; and

WHEREAS, Andritz Separation, Inc. has previously been awarded a contract for such work in and amount not to exceed of \$54,000.00; and

WHEREAS, upon disassembly, cleaning, and inspection at the Andritz facility, the scroll and bowl assembly were characterized with atypical damage, requiring an additional \$36,000 to complete the repair of this essential equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to modify contract documents with Andritz Separation, Inc. for the repair and replacement of certain equipment at the Water Reclamation Plant on behalf of the City of Mason, pursuant to the proposal attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Andritz Separation, Inc. an additional fee not to exceed \$36,000 for such additional work pursuant to the attached proposal.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its adoption. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to complete the repairs at the earliest possible date to avoid interruption of services at the Water Reclamation Plant.
