## **ORDINANCE 2018 - 11**

## AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS WITH DAVEY TREE COMPANY FOR AS NEEDED TREE REMOVAL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it will be necessary to engage in certain tree removal services in order to ensure public safety; and

WHEREAS, Davey Tree Company is a vendor qualified to perform such services; and

WHEREAS, City Council now desires to authorize the City Manager to enter into contracts for those needed tree removal services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

- <u>Section 1.</u> That the City of Mason declares that Davey Tree Company is a vendor qualified to perform required tree removal services.
- <u>Section 2.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into contracts with Davey Tree Company to perform required tree removal services.
- <u>Section 3.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said Davey Tree Company a sum not to exceed \$125,000 for all required cumulative tree removal services.
- <u>Section 4.</u> That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its adoption. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to enter into contracts for tree removal services at the earliest possible date in order to ensure public safety.
