ORDINANCE 2018 - 26

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH TIM LALLY CHEVROLET FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) 2018 CHEVY TAHOE POLICE PACKAGE VEHICLES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$71,835.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has advertised and received bids for the purchase of

vehicles under the State Bid Program; and

WHEREAS, Tim Lally Chevrolet was the best bidder with a bid of \$71,835 for the

purchase of two (2) 2018 Chevy Tahoe Police Package Vehicles for use by the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio,

six members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City of Mason accepts the State's vehicle specifications and agrees that Tim Lally Chevrolet is the best bidder.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Tim Lally Chevrolet for the purchase of two (2) 2018 Chevy Tahoe Police Package Vehicles.

<u>Section 3.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Tim Lally Chevrolet the total sum of \$71,835 for said vehicles.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
