ORDINANCE 2018 – 27

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH LEBANON FORD FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) 2018 FORD INTERCEPTOR UTILITY SUV'S IN THE AMOUNT OF \$57,882.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has advertised and received bids for the purchase of vehicles under the State Bid Program; and

WHEREAS, Lebanon Ford was the best bidder with a bid of \$57,882 for the purchase of two (2) 2018 Ford Interceptor Utility SUV's for use by the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City of Mason accepts the State's vehicle specifications and agrees that Lebanon Ford is the best bidder.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Lebanon Ford for the purchase of two (2) 2018 Ford Interceptor Utility SUV's.

<u>Section 3.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Lebanon Ford the total sum of \$57,882 for said vehicles.

<u>Section 4.</u> That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
