

ORDINANCE 2018 - 91

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ESTABLISH CERTAIN
ADDITIONAL POSITIONS IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the Mason Campus, comprised of a combination of public and private facilities, including City facilities, school buildings, parks, and private offices, presents the City with a unique area that can include over 11,000 individuals on a normal work day; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has explored new approaches to providing security to the Campus area; and

WHEREAS, Council has previously established a Campus Security Program in order to best serve the citizens and businesses of the City of Mason; and

WHEREAS, the City is currently working with Mason City Schools to develop a Memorandum of Understanding in order to more fully develop and implement the Campus Security Program; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the Campus Security Program, Council has determined a need to establish additional positions in the Police Department in order to provide the necessary flexibility to allow for full staffing levels throughout the department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to establish a total of five (5) additional positions in the Police Department.

Section 2. That the following positions are hereby established within the City of Mason, with associated compensation ranges:

Compensation:

One Full-time Police Lieutenant to be assigned to the Campus Security Program

Per collective bargaining agreement

Two Full-time Police Officers to be assigned to the Campus Security Program

Per collective bargaining agreement

Two Full-time Police Officers to provide full staffing level flexibility

Per collective bargaining agreement

Section 3. That all approved full-time positions, whether filled or vacant, shall be as set forth in Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
