ORDINANCE 2018 – 94

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH MASON CITY SCHOOLS REGARDING THE CAMPUS SECURITY PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Mason Campus, comprised of a combination of public and private facilities, including City facilities, school buildings, parks, and private offices, presents the City with a unique area that can include over 11,000 individuals on a normal work day; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has explored new approaches to providing security to the Campus area; and

WHEREAS, Council has previously established a Campus Security Program in order to best serve the citizens and businesses of the City of Mason; and

WHEREAS, the City and Mason City Schools have developed a Memorandum of Understanding in order to more fully develop and implement the Campus Security Program; and

WHEREAS, Council now desires to approve the Memorandum of Understanding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio,

seven members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Mason City Schools related to the Campus Security Program, substantially in the form of the memorandum attached hereto as Exhibit A, incorporated herein by reference.

<u>Section 2.</u> That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
