ORDINANCE 2018 – 96

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A LIFEGUARD AND LIFEGUARD SUPERVISION AGREEMENT WITH CINCINNATI POOL MANAGEMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Mason owns and operates the Leisure and Whirlpool Spa and Competition pools at the Community Center and the Lou Eves Municipal pool and related fixtures, amenities and equipment, and sought services to provide pool lifeguard and lifeguard supervision and related services; and

WHEREAS, Cincinnati Pool Management is in the business of managing, operating and servicing community swimming pools and pool areas; and

WHEREAS, Cincinnati Pool Management has submitted an acceptable proposal to the City of Mason.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a Lifeguard and Lifeguard Supervision Agreement substantially in the form of the agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Cincinnati Pool Management pursuant to the terms of said Lifeguard and Lifeguard Supervision Agreement for the initial term of the Agreement and any applicable renewal periods.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to have lifeguard services in place at the earliest possible date.
