

ORDINANCE 2018 - 98

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH ENVIRONMENTAL REMEDIATION CONTRACTOR FOR THE MUDDY CREEK REHABILITATION AND STREAMBANK STABILIZATION PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$522,831 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City solicited bids for the Muddy Creek Rehabilitation and Streambank Stabilization Project; and

WHEREAS, Environmental Remediation Contractor submitted the lowest and best bid with a base bid of \$494,782, and a bid for the Alternate of \$28,048, for a total bid of \$522,831.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the contract for the Muddy Creek Rehabilitation and Streambank Stabilization Project is awarded to Environmental Remediation Contractor at the not to exceed proposed fee amount of \$522,831.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute contract documents with Environmental Remediation Contractor on behalf of the City of Mason.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is authorized to make payment to Environmental Remediation Contractor on the basis of approved payment applications, up to the contract amount of \$522,831.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon adoption. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to begin the project at the earliest possible date due to the severity of the existing erosion.
