

**ORDINANCE 2018 – 106**

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FEDERAL RESOURCES TO PROVIDE HAZARDOUS MATERIALS RESPONSE TRAINING TO THE FIRE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, Council has determined that there is a need to provide basic hazardous materials response training to the Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the City received a quote from Federal Resources to provide three days of hazardous materials response training in the amount of \$16,850; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department in collaboration with NEFC departments obtained a reimbursement grant from the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio in the amount of \$9,034.14 to help offset the cost of this training.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That Fire Department successfully applied for joint grant with the Northeast Fire Collaborative to help offset the cost of training.

Section 2. That the City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Federal Resources for the delivery of HazMat IQ training.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Federal Resources the sum of up to \$16,850 for the delivery of HazMat IQ training.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
