ORDINANCE 2018 – 106

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FEDERAL RESOURCES TO PROVIDE HAZARDOUS MATERIALS RESPONSE TRAINING TO THE FIRE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, Council has determined that there is a need to provide basic hazardous materials response training to the Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the City received a quote from Federal Resources to provide three days of hazardous materials response training in the amount of \$16,850; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department in collaboration with NEFC departments obtained a reimbursement grant from the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio in the amount of \$9,034.14 to help offset the cost of this training.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

- <u>Section 1.</u> That Fire Department successfully applied for joint grant with the Northeast Fire Collaborative to help offset the cost of training.
- <u>Section 2.</u> That the City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Federal Resources for the delivery of HazMat IQ training.
- <u>Section 3.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Federal Resources the sum of up to \$16,850 for the delivery of HazMat IQ training.
- <u>Section 4.</u> That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
