

ORDINANCE 2018 – 126

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH HACH FOR THE PURCHASE OF DISSOLVED OXYGEN AND OXIDATION REDUCTION POTENTIAL SENSORS AND PROBES FOR THE WATER RECLAMATION PLANT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$40,000 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has determined that certain equipment is necessary for the continued efficient operation of the Water Reclamation Plant; and

WHEREAS, Hach has provided a proposal for such equipment at an amount not to exceed of \$40,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, five members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason accepts the proposal from Hach for the purchase of dissolved oxygen and oxidation reduction potential sensors and probes for the Water Reclamation Plant.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute contract documents with Hach for said equipment at the Water Reclamation Plant on behalf of the City of Mason, pursuant to the proposal attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its adoption. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to complete the purchase for the equipment at the earliest possible date to avoid interruption of services at the Water Reclamation Plant.
