ORDINANCE 2018 – 51

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH STRAND ASSOCIATES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$48,500 FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE OXIDATION DITCH AERATION PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has received a quote, in the amount of \$48,500 from

Strand Associates for engineering services related to the oxidation ditch aeration project at the

Water Reclamation Plant; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 133.05 of the Mason Codified Ordinances,

competitive bidding is not required for such purchase; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio,

seven members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Strand Associates for engineering services related to the oxidation ditch aeration project, substantially in the form of the contract attached hereto as Exhibit A, incorporated herein by reference.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Strand Associates an amount not to exceed \$48,500 pursuant to the terms of the contract for said services.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its adoption. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to authorize the engineering services at the earliest possible date to avoid interruption of services at the Water Reclamation Plant.
