ORDINANCE 2018 – 54

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MOODY'S INCORPORATED IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$50,000 FOR REHABILITATION AND REPAIR OF IRRIGATION WELLS AT THE GOLF CENTER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has received a quote from Moody's Incorporated for services related to the rehabilitation and repair of irrigation wells at the Golf Center; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 133.05 of the Mason Codified Ordinances, competitive bidding is not required for such purchase; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Moody's Incorporated for services related to the rehabilitation and repair of irrigation wells at the Golf Center, substantially in the form of the contract attached hereto as Exhibit A, incorporated herein by reference.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Moody's Incorporated an amount not to exceed \$50,000 pursuant to the terms of the contract for said services.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its adoption. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to authorize the services at the earliest possible date to avoid interruption of services at the Golf Center.
