

RESOLUTION 2018 – 3

**RECOGNIZING THE 2018 RACE TO ANYPLACE FUNDRAISING
EVENTS AS THE “NINTH ANNUAL KEN MURAWSKI RACE TO ANYPLACE”**

WHEREAS, Ken Murawski gave dedicated service to the City of Mason, Ohio, serving on the Zoning Board of Appeals from 1996 to 2000, and then on Planning Commission from August 2000 to February 2014; and

WHEREAS, Ken was involved in over 145 cases while on the Zoning Board of Appeals and over 790 cases during his tenure on Planning Commission, including 20 residential subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, Ken experienced the growth in population of the City of Mason from an estimated 14,000 residents in 1996 to an estimated over 32,300 residents in 2014; and

WHEREAS, Ken was also an advocate for the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society’s campaigns and served on its Tri-State Chapter Board of Trustees from 2006 to 2012. Ken founded the Race to Anyplace in the LLS Tri-State chapter which, in the five years since its inception, raised over \$150,000; and

WHEREAS, in 2013, Ken served as the Light the Night Corporate Chair for the Cincinnati and Mason area which raised approximately \$90,000; and

WHEREAS, Ken’s professionalism, work ethic, and keen insight directly contributed to Mason’s historic and current success while his service, commitment, and compassion earned him many friends and set Mason on course for a successful future; and

WHEREAS, by said service, Ken made the City of Mason a better place in which to live, and Ken lent a dignity and determination that will remain an example to all who associated with him

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio:

Section 1. That the 2018 Race to Anyplace be named the “Ninth Annual Ken Murawski Race to Anyplace” in memory of Ken Murawski and for his dedicated service to the City of Mason.

Section 2. That the Clerk of Council be and is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to Ken Murawski’s Family, and the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
