ORDINANCE 2019 – 43

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH RUMPKE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$16,008 TO PROVIDE TRASH DISPOSAL SERVICES AND PORTABLE BATHROOMS FOR THE 2019 RED, RHYTHM AND BOOM EVENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Mason is celebrating Independence Day in 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City has contracted for restrooms and trash disposal from Rumpke in the amount not-to-exceed \$16,008 in accordance with the terms of the proposal;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the proposal of Rumpke in the amount not-to-exceed \$16,008 for restrooms, dumpsters, and trash disposal services during events related to the City's Independence Day celebration is hereby accepted.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Rumpke to provide restrooms and trash disposal services according to the specifications set forth by the City.

<u>Section 3.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized and directed to pay Rumpke the sum not-to-exceed \$16,008 in accordance with the terms of the proposal.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Section 4.</u> That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its adoption. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to execute the contract to reduce interruption in the event planning process.
