AN**ORDINANCE ACCEPTING** THE **PROPOSAL FOR** PRECONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR THE LOU EVES MUNICIPAL **POOL** REDEVELOPMENT **PROJECT FROM** THE **CONGER** CONSTRUCTION GROUP, INC., FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FEE OF \$53,508 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE **CONTRACT DOCUMENTS** AND **DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City of Mason received a proposal for Preconstruction Services for the Lou Eves Municipal Pool Redevelopment Project; and

WHEREAS, Conger Construction Group, Inc. is most qualified consultant to design the Lou Eves Municipal Pool Redevelopment Project as outlined in a proposal in an amount not to exceed fee of \$53,508.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members thereto concurring:

- <u>Section 1.</u> That the proposal for the Lou Eves Municipal Pool Redevelopment Project is authorized for Conger Construction Group, Inc. for the not to exceed fee amount of \$53,508.
- <u>Section 2.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute contract documents with the Conger Construction Group, Inc. on behalf of the City of Mason.
- <u>Section 3.</u> That the Finance Director is authorized to make payment to the Conger Construction Group, Inc. on the basis of approved payment applications, up to the contract amount of \$53,508.
- <u>Section 4.</u> That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its adoption. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to execute the contract for the project to proceed on schedule at the close of the 2019 pool season.
