SUPPORTING WARREN COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT TEN YEAR 0.5 MILL REPLACEMENT TAX LEVY

WHEREAS, the Warren County Health Department is charged with enforcing health codes that impact the public health, safety, and welfare of virtually every citizen of Warren County every day; and

WHEREAS, the Warren County Health Department inspects every permanent restaurant, school cafeteria, grocery store, and from one to four times a year and even inspects temporary festival food vendors to ensure proper sanitation and food handling techniques; and

WHEREAS, the Warren County Health Department also approves every lot slated to receive an on-lot sewage disposal system along with inspecting and approving the installation of every household sewage treatment system as it is installed; and

WHEREAS, the Warren County Health Department routinely inspects and addresses public nuisance complaints ranging from trash to housing violations; and

WHEREAS, the Warren County Health Department inspects and approves the plumbing for all commercial and residential buildings constructed throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, the Warren County Health Department routinely provides a large variety of medical care programs more routinely associated with departments of health; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio hereby supports the passing of the Ten Year 0.5 Mill Replacement Tax Levy proposed by the Warren County Health Department for approval by voters on November 5, 2019.

Section 2. That this Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
