ORDINANCE 2020 – 14

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH LEBANON FORD FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) 2020 FORD POLICE INTERCEPTOR UTILITY VEHICLES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$74,219.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has advertised and received bids for the purchase of vehicles under the State Bid Program; and

WHEREAS, Lebanon Ford was the best bidder with a bid of \$74,219 for the purchase of one (2) 2020 Ford Police Interceptor Utility vehicles for use by the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City of Mason accepts the State's vehicle specifications and agrees that Lebanon Ford is the best bidder.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Lebanon Ford for the purchase of two (2) 2020 Ford Police Interceptor Utility Vehicles.

<u>Section 3.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Lebanon Ford the total sum of \$74,219 for said vehicles.

<u>Section 4.</u> That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
