

ORDINANCE 2020 – 22

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH HPT FOR THE PURCHASE OF PARTS AND MATERIALS USED FOR UV DISINFECTION EQUIPMENT FOR THE WATER RECLAMATION PLANT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$113,000

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has determined that certain equipment is necessary for the continued efficient operation of the Water Reclamation Plant; and

WHEREAS, HPT has provided a proposal for such equipment at an amount not to exceed of \$113,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason accepts the proposal from HPT for the purchase of parts and materials used for the upgrading of the existing UV disinfection equipment at the Water Reclamation Plant.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute contract documents with HPT for said equipment at the Water Reclamation Plant on behalf of the City of Mason, pursuant to the proposal attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay HPT an amount not to exceed \$113,000 pursuant to the terms of said proposal.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall be effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
