

ORDINANCE 2020 – 36

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH MIDWEST CRICKET ACADEMY AND AUTHORIZING RELATED CONTRACTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, THE City of Mason has expressed a desire to partner with the Midwest Cricket Academy to expand recreational facilities and offerings in the community; and

WHEREAS, the City and Midwest Cricket Academy have developed a Memorandum of Understanding in order to more fully develop and implement the recreational partnership opportunity; and

WHEREAS, Council now desires to approve the Memorandum of Understanding and related contracts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Midwest Cricket Academy related to the construction of cricket pitch at Thomas P. Quinn Park, substantially in the form of the memorandum attached hereto as Exhibit A, incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. That the City Manager is further authorized to enter into an agreement with Middleton Construction in an amount not to exceed \$15,000 for the construction of the cricket pitch.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is authorized to pay Middleton Construction an amount not to exceed \$15,000 for said construction.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and shall be effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to enter into the memorandum of understanding the earliest possible date in order to ensure the timely construction of the facility..
