ORDINANCE 2020 - 37

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH JACK DOHENY COMPANY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$31,426 FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE STORM AND SANITARY PIPE LINE CAMERA

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has received a quote, in an amount not to exceed \$31,426 from Jack Doheny Company for the purchase of one storm and sanitary pipe line camera; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 133.05 of the Mason Codified Ordinances, competitive bidding is not required for such purchase; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio,

seven members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Jack Doheny Company for the purchase of one storm and sanitary pipe line camera.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Jack Doheny Company an amount not to exceed \$31,426 for such purchase.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
