

ORDINANCE 2020 - 48

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH HOUCK ASPHALT MAINTENANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,402 FOR ASPHALT MAINTENANCE AT QUINN PARK, A PORTION OF BIKE PATH ALONG MASON-MONTGOMERY ROAD, DOWNTOWN PARKING LOTS AND SPECIFIC GOLF CENTER CART PATHS

WHEREAS, cost proposals were received for asphalt maintenance at Quinn Park, portion of bike path along Mason-Montgomery Road, downtown parking lots and specific Golf Center cart paths; and

WHEREAS, Houck Asphalt Maintenance was the best proposal with a price of \$50,402 for the work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the proposal from Houck Asphalt Maintenance in the amount of \$50,402 for the asphalt maintenance at Quinn Park, portion of Bike Path along Mason-Montgomery Road, downtown parking lots and specific Golf Center cart paths to repair, crack seal, seal coat, and re-stripe is hereby accepted.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Houck Asphalt Maintenance for asphalt maintenance at Quinn Park, portion of Bike Path along Mason-Montgomery Road, downtown parking lots and specific Golf Center cart paths, according to the specifications set forth by the City.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby directed to pay said Houck Asphalt Maintenance the sum of \$50,402 for said work.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
