

ORDINANCE 2020 – 98

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CARGILL, INC FOR THE PURCHASE OF APPROXIMATELY 5,500 TONS OF HIGHWAY ROCK SALT AT \$47.22 PER TON

WHEREAS, the Southwest Ohio Purchasers for Government has advertised and received bids for the purchase of bulk highway rock salt for snow and ice control; and

WHEREAS, Cargill, Inc, was the lowest and best bidder with a bid of \$47.22 per ton.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason accepts the Southwest Ohio Purchasers for Government bulk ice control salt specifications and agrees that Cargill, Inc is the lowest and best bidder.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Cargill, Inc for the purchase of 5,500 tons of salt, more or less.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said Cargill, Inc the sum of \$47.22 per ton.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
