ORDINANCE 2020 – 98

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CARGILL, INC FOR THE PURCHASE OF APPROXIMATELY 5,500 TONS OF HIGHWAY ROCK SALT AT \$47.22 PER TON

WHEREAS, the Southwest Ohio Purchasers for Government has advertised and received bids for the purchase of bulk highway rock salt for snow and ice control; and

WHEREAS, Cargill, Inc, was the lowest and best bidder with a bid of \$47.22 per ton.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City of Mason accepts the Southwest Ohio Purchasers for Government bulk ice control salt specifications and agrees that Cargill, Inc is the lowest and best bidder.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Cargill, Inc for the purchase of 5,500 tons of salt, more or less.

<u>Section 3.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said Cargill, Inc the sum of \$47.22 per ton.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
