DISCUSSION OF ORDINANCE 2020-46

Councilmember Bradburn read a statement sharing concerns of meeting too often without constructive Committee meetings and hindering the ability to conduct business productively. He stated local businesses may be deterred to find financial help through resources provided by State and Federal outlets due to miscommunication to the public. He stated the need to assess the magnitude of impact on City's finances and evaluate the federal program and restart of the economy. A motion to refer Ordinance 2020-46 to committees and suspend and table any other discussions and matters involving small businesses, the Chamber and CDC as well as any discussions, proposals or legislation about these matters for which three members can call a meeting until the Economic Development and Finance Committees finish their meetings and investigations and report back to Council was made by Councilmember Bradburn, seconded by Councilmember Honerlaw.
