ORDINANCE 2021 – 47

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FEDERAL SIGNAL IN THE AMOUNT OF \$54,742 FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF TWO OUTDOOR WARNING SIRENS

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has received a quote, in the amount of \$54,742, from Federal Signal for the replacement of two rotating electromechanical outdoor warning siren; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 133.05 of the Mason Codified Ordinances, competitive bidding is not required for such purchase; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Federal Signal for the replacement of two outdoor warning sirens.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Federal Signal an amount not to exceed \$54,742 for the replacement of two outdoor warning sirens.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this Ordinance shall be effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
