

ORDINANCE 2021 – 98

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL FOR RIGHT OF WAY ACQUISITION SERVICES FOR SR 741 WIDENING PROJECT (COX-SMITH ROAD TO SPYGLASS HILL) FROM PALMER ENGINEERING COMPANY, IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FEE OF \$74,785 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has contracted with Palmer Engineering Company for design services for the SR 741 widening from Cox-Smith Road to SpyGlass Hill.

WHEREAS, the Palmer Engineering Company submitted a right of way acquisition fee proposal for SR 741 Widening Project (Cox-Smith to Spyglass Hill) in an amount not to exceed fee of \$74,785.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the proposal for the SR 741 Widening Project (Cox-Smith to Spyglass Hill) right of way acquisition services is authorized for Palmer Engineering, at the not to exceed proposed fee amount of \$74,785.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute contract documents with Palmer Engineering on behalf of the City of Mason.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is authorized to make payment to Palmer Engineering, on the basis of approved payment applications, up to the contract amount of \$74,785.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
