

ORDINANCE 2021 – 109

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH HASTINGS AIR ENERGY CONTROL, INC. TO OVERHAUL THE DIESEL EXHAUST REMOVAL SYSTEM AT FIRE STATION 52

WHEREAS, the City, committed to the health and wellness of staff, first installed a diesel exhaust removal system in the apparatus bay during the construction of Fire Station 52;

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has determined the need to overhaul and upgrade the system to utilize improved technology to meet current service needs and demands;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason is committed to providing the necessary equipment to manage and improve workplace safety and wishes to continue to minimize the risk of occupational cancer for fire department employees.

Section 2. That the City of Mason accepts the quoted price from Hastings Air Energy Control, Inc, to overhaul and upgrade the diesel exhaust removal system at Fire Station 52.

Section 3. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Hastings Air Energy Control, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$23,900 for the labor and equipment needed to complete the overhaul of the system.

Section 4. That the Finance Director is authorized to pay Hastings Air Energy Control, Inc. a sum not to exceed \$23,900 for said equipment.

Section 5. That this Ordinance shall be effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
