ORDINANCE 2021 – 127

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FYDA FREIGHTLINER CINCINNATI, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) 2022 FREIGHTLINER M2 DUMP TRUCK IN THE AMOUNT OF \$90,860 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has advertised and received bids for the purchase of vehicles under the State Bid Program; and

WHEREAS, Fyda Freightliner Cincinnati, Inc. was the best bidder with a bid of \$90,860 for the purchase of one (1) 2022 Freightliner M2 Dump Truck for use by the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

- <u>Section 1.</u> That the City of Mason accepts the State's vehicle specifications and agrees that Fyda Freightliner Cincinnati, Inc. is the best bidder.
- Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Fyda Freightliner Cincinnati, Inc. for the purchase of one (1) 2022 Freightliner M2 Dump Truck.
- <u>Section 3.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Fyda Freightliner Cincinnati, Inc. the total sum of \$90,860 for said vehicle.
- <u>Section 4.</u> That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its adoption. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to execute the contract at the earliest possible date.
