

ORDINANCE 2021 – 129

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CENTURY EQUIPMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE TORO 4000-D MOWER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$71,172 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has advertised and received bids for the purchase of vehicles and equipment under the State Bid Program; and

WHEREAS, Century Equipment was the best bidder with a bid of \$71,172 for the purchase of one Toro 4000-D mower for use by the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason accepts the State’s equipment specifications and agrees that Century Equipment is the best bidder.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Century Equipment for the purchase of one Toro 4000-D mower.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Century Equipment the total sum of \$71,172 for said equipment.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its adoption. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to execute the contract at the earliest possible date.
