ORDINANCE 2022 – 33

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH RICHARDS ELECTRIC FOR REPLACEMENT LIGHTING MATERIALS AT THE MASON VETERANS' MEMORIAL IN AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED \$20,000 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has received bids for replacement lighting materials at the Mason Veterans' Memorial; and

WHEREAS, Richards Electric was the best quote for replacement lighting materials at the Mason Veterans' Memorial.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Richards Electric for replacement lighting materials at the Mason Veterans' Memorial.

<u>Section 1.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Richards Electric in an amount not-to-exceed \$20,000 for said lighting materials.

<u>Section 2.</u> That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its adoption. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to execute the contract at the earliest possible date.
