

ORDINANCE 2022 – 35

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR THE SB 310 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT COMMUNITY RECREATION PROJECT FOR THE ADAPTIVE BALLFIELDS AT MAKINO PARK

WHEREAS, the City of Mason proposes to enter into an Agreement with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for four hundred thousand dollars (\$675,000) toward the Adaptive Ballfields at Makino Park; and

WHEREAS, by entering into an agreement with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for the grant, the City of Mason will realize cost benefits and be able to complete work associated with the Adaptive Ballfields at Makino Park; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, five members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute any and all documents necessary to acquire said agreement.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its adoption. The reason for said declaration of emergency is to proceed with a timely execution of the agreement with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources.
