

ORDINANCE 2022 – 75

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS WITH VARIOUS VENDORS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$250,000 FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A DOG PARK AT MASON SPORTS PARK

WHEREAS, the City has determined that development of a dog park at Mason Sports Park is consistent with the mission of the Parks and Recreation Department; and

WHEREAS, said development will include, but not be limited to fencing, turf, concrete work and other miscellaneous items; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to give staff the flexibility to work with multiple vendors for different components of the development needs in order to better determine the most efficient method of operation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, 5 members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into multiple contracts with various vendors for the development of a dog park at Mason Sports Park.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said vendors a total amount not to exceed \$250,000 for said development.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
