ORDINANCE 2022 – 77

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CINCINNATI BELL IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,500 PER MONTH FOR SERVICES AT THE GRIZZLY GOLF AND SOCIAL LODGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, proposals were received for a contract to provide phone, internet and cable television services; and

WHEREAS, the initial term of the contract is for thirty six (36) months with optional twelve (12) month renewals after the initial term.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio,

- <u>Section 1.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Cincinnati Bell dba Altafiber for said services, according to the specifications set forth by the City and as further determined by City staff.
- <u>Section 3</u>. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Cincinnati Bell dba Altafiber a total amount not to exceed \$1,500 per month for said services.
- <u>Section 4.</u> That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its adoption. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to execute the contract at the earliest possible date.
