

ORDINANCE 2022 – 102

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH GANLEY CHEVROLET OF AURORA LLC FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) CHEVROLET TAHOE POLICE PACKAGE VEHICLES IN A NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$90,000 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the purchase of Chevy Tahoe Police Package Vehicles has been identified as a need for the City of Mason; and

WHEREAS, Ganley Chevrolet of Aurora LLC. is the best bidder for the purchase of two (2) Chevy Tahoe Police Package Vehicles for use by the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Ganley Chevrolet of Aurora LLC for the purchase of two (2) Chevy Tahoe Police Package Vehicles.

Section 1. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Ganley Chevrolet of Aurora LLC an amount equal to the identified bid price, not to exceed an aggregate of \$90,000 for said vehicles.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its adoption. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to execute the contract at the earliest possible date.
