

RESOLUTION 2022 – 28

**COMMENDING CHIEF JOHN MOORE FOR HIS OUTSTANDING
DEDICATION AND SERVICE TO THE CITY OF MASON, OHIO**

WHEREAS, Safety Director and former Fire Chief John Moore is retiring after giving over fifteen years of dedicated service to the City of Mason, Ohio, serving as Fire Chief from 2007 to 2018 and Safety Director from 2009 to 2022; and

WHEREAS, in addition to his service with the City of Mason, Chief John Moore has dedicated 50 years of his life in the Fire and Safety Service industry, beginning as a volunteer Firefighter in 1973 and serving the Dayton Fire Department from 1975 to 2007 where he served in multiple capacities including Assistant Fire Chief; and

WHEREAS, many Fire and EMS initiatives were established during Chief Moore's leadership of the Mason Fire Department including the reorganization of the Department, the opening of Fire Station 51, the Safety Services Charter Amendment, revitalization of the City's Emergency Operations Center, and strengthening of the City's Fire/Rescue/EMS training programs; and

WHEREAS, in addition to his contributions to the Mason Fire Department, Chief John Moore was instrumental in developing City Team One, the City's leadership development program that has graduated 57 full time employees since its inception in 2016; and

WHEREAS, Chief Moore has served as the City's liaison for The Grizzly Golf and Social Lodge since 2009, helping to align course and facility operations with the City's vision as a community wellness asset; and

WHEREAS, with honor, integrity and compassion, Chief Moore has impacted the lives of many, and his influence will have a profound impact on the future of Mason; and

WHEREAS, Mason City Council, staff, and community wish Chief Moore continued success and happiness in retirement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio:

Section 1. That Chief Moore is hereby given the commendation of the Council of the City of Mason for his outstanding and distinguished service to said City.

Section 2. That the Clerk of Council is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to Chief John Moore.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
