ORDINANCE 2023 – 26

AMENDING CHAPTER 335 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MASON, OHIO, REGARDING FAILURE TO REPORT AN ACCIDENT

WHEREAS, chapter 335 of the Mason codified ordinances generally governs the licensing of vehicles and accidents; and

WHEREAS, the municipal prosecutor has identified a state law providing for the prohibition against failing to report an accident that is otherwise not found in the codified ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Counsel now desires to include such section in the codified ordinances.

NOW, THEREORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That Chapter 335 of the Mason Codified Ordinances is hereby amended to include the new section 335.131 which shall read as follows:

335.131 PROHIBITION AGAINST FAILURE TO REPORT THE ACCIDENT

- (a) No person shall fail to report a motor vehicle accident as required under the laws of this state.
- (b) Whoever violates this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor.

<u>Section 2.</u> That all other provisions of the Codified Ordinances not specifically amended herein shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
