ORDINANCE 2023 – 71

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO ALTERNATE CONTRACTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF HIGHWAY ROCK SALT IN AN AGGREGATE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$250,000

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has determined it is in the best interest of the city to provide for alternate means of purchasing highway rock salt; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to give the City Manager the authority to enter into such alternate contracts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into alternate contracts for the purchase of highway rock salt in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$250,000.

<u>Section 2</u>. That pursuant to section 133.05 of the Mason Codified Ordinances, the City Manager is authorized to make such purchase without advertising and competitive bidding.

<u>Section 3.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay the identified vendor or vendors an aggregate amount not to exceed \$250,000 for said purchases.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
