ORDINANCE 2023 – 84

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MCCLUSKEY CHEVROLET FOR THE PURCHASE OF FOUR (4) CHEVY POLICE CRUISERS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City has requested prices for the purchase of police cruisers; and

WHEREAS, due to the high demand and long wait times for police cruisers, Council desires to authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract with McCluskey Chevrolet for the purchase of four (4) Chevy Police Cruisers for use by the Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with McCluskey Chevrolet for the purchase of four (4) Chevy Police Cruisers.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay McCluskey Chevrolet the total sum not to exceed \$240,000 for said cruisers.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its adoption. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to place the orders at the earliest possible date while the vehicles are still in stock.
