ORDINANCE 2024 – 11

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FELDKAMP ENTERPRISES INC. FOR INSTALLATION OF CHLORAMINE EVACUATOR SYSTEMS AT THE MASON MUNICIPAL AQUATIC CENTER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$81,000

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has received a quote from Feldkamp Enterprises, Inc. for installation of chloramine evacuator systems in the amount of \$81,000; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 133.05 of the Mason Codified Ordinances, competitive bidding is not required for such purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Feldkamp Enterprises, Inc. for installation of chloramine evacuator systems in the amount of \$81,000.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Feldkamp Enterprises, Inc. the sum not to exceed \$81,000 for said work.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is to procure and install the chloramine evacuator system within the current swim meet season.
