## **ORDINANCE 2024 – 12**

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH PROCESS CONSTRUCTION INC. FOR REPLACEMENT OF A POOL BOILER SYSTEM AT THE MASON MUNICIPAL AQUATIC CENTER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$69,000

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has received two quotes from replacement of a pool boiler system at the Mason Municipal Aquatic Center; and

WHEREAS, tabulation and analysis of the quotes indicates that the lowest and best quote was provided by Process Construction Inc. in the total amount of \$69,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

- <u>Section 1.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Process Construction Inc. for replacement of a pool boiler system in the amount of \$69,000.
- <u>Section 2.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Process Construction Inc. the sum not to exceed \$69,000 for said work.
- <u>Section 3.</u> That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the current boiler system is non-operable.
