

ORDINANCE 2024 – 16

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH VALOR OUTFITTERS FOR THE REMOVAL, TRANSFER, PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT INTO FIVE (5) NEW POLICE VEHICLES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$116,325

WHEREAS, The City wishes to remove, transfer, purchase and install new emergency equipment into five (5) new police vehicles; and

WHEREAS, City staff has obtained quotes for this equipment and services; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason accepts the quote provided by Valor Outfitters and agrees that Valor Outfitters is the best bidder.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Valor Outfitters. for the removal, transfer, purchase and installation of emergency equipment into five (5) new police vehicles in the amount of \$116,325.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Valor Outfitters the total sum of \$116,325 for said services and equipment.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
